Subject: Heritage Passport Card for Year 1 students (Scholastic Year 2025–2026)

Date: 29 October 2025

Heads of College Networks and Heads of Primary Schools are kindly asked to note the following communication.

Heritage Malta, with the collaboration of the Ministry for Education, Sport, Youth, Research and Innovation will be issuing a serialised **Heritage Malta Passport Card** for pupils who have started Year 1 in September 2025. Expiry date for this card is 2036.

State Primary Schools will be receiving the Heritage Malta Passport Cards for their Year 1 pupils from the Office of their respective Head of College Network.

Primary Church Schools will be receiving the Heritage Malta Passport Cards via the Secretariat for Catholic Education.

Independent Schools who have Year 1 pupils will be contacted by email when and from where the Heritage Malta Passport Cards may be collected.

Once the Heritage Malta Passport Cards reach the school, all Year 1 pupils will receive:

- A serialised Heritage Malta Passport Card with expiry year 2036;
- A brochure for Parents/Guardians from Heritage Malta.
